


# Battle of Short Hills

# Historical Significance

- The **Battle of Short Hills**, which took place **June 26th 1777**, embodies the ideal of the American struggle during the War for Independence.
- It was here, on the farmland of modern Union County, that American patriots went head-to- head with the British Empire.
- Holding off a two pronged attack, the fledgling New Jersey Brigade fought a gallant retreat, keeping the advancing redcoats at bay while the rest of the Continental Army marched to the safety of the Watchung Mountains.



# Historical Significance

- This strategic victory set the stage for the survival of the state as an American territory and forced the British to try a new approach to regaining their colonies.
- New Jersey men defended this land in the name of Liberty, let us remember their sacrifice and bring their memory home for the 250th Anniversary year.

**Oak Ridge Park in Union County will once again be used for this event and to make a connection to the surrounding townships.**

- The grounds border, if not are actually part of, the original Battle of Short Hills and are host to an original dwelling from the 1730s.
- Ample parking is available as well as the opportunity for living historians and reenactors to set up period camps and safely conduct a tactical battle demonstration.
- Historic programming teaching about 18<sup>th</sup> century soldiery, minorities, civilians, and material culture will take place throughout the weekend.


# 2017 Park Map
